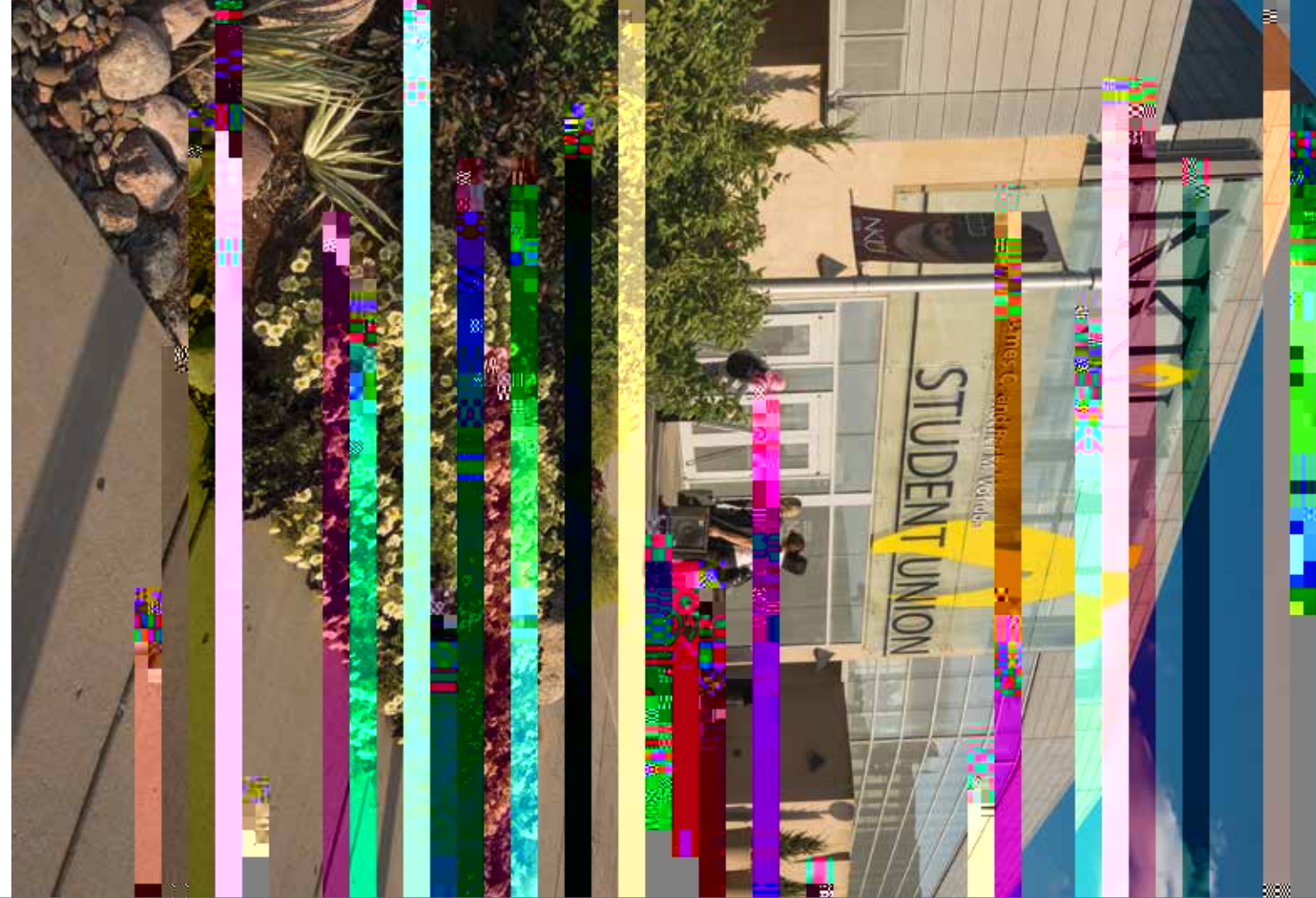


- Reports personal, mental health/medical housing or other concerns impacting staying in school
- Discloses overwhelming family concerns
- Becomes hospitalized or reports experiencing serious illness
- Expresses a desire to withdraw from school
- Presents as depressed, hopeless or excessively anxious
- Expresses suicidal ideation or self-injurious behaviors
- Struggling with mental health
- Expresses an interest in starting therapy

- Discloses needing support in filing a Title IX complaint
- Reports academic difficulty due to a physical, psychological or learning disability
- Communicates a need for disability accommodations
- Communicates being a victim of sexual assault, stalking, dating violence, domestic violence, sexual exploitation, sexual harassment, sex/gender discrimination, pregnancy or related conditions, sex stereotypes and characteristics, or any related issue
- Discloses wanting to pursue a Title IX process at NKU
- Reports struggling academically
- Routinely misses class, arrives late and/or fails to submit assignments
- Reports financial concerns
- Threatens (or reports) a threat to safety of self or others
- Experiences a medical emergency or mental health crisis
- Experiences a crime on campus
